Creative Energy Mount Pleasant Limited Partnership Application to Acquire, Operate and Expand a Thermal Energy System for Cooling at the Main Alley Development

On March 10, 2020, Creative Energy Mount Pleasant Limited Partnership filed an application with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, pursuant to sections 45 and 46 of the *Utilities Commission Act*.

In the Application, Creative Energy Mount Pleasant Limited Partnership, seeks approval to acquire and operate the existing Mount Pleasant district cooling system, and to expand and operate the system to provide cooling to the Main Alley Development in the Mount Pleasant neighbourhood of Vancouver. The BCUC has established a public hearing process for the review of the Application.
