On August 28, 2019, Creative Energy Vancouver Platforms Inc. (Creative Energy) filed an application with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) pursuant to sections 45 and 46 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA) to acquire and operate a district thermal energy system to provide cooling to the Vancouver House Development in the South Downtown area of Vancouver (Application). The BCUC considers that establishing a public hearing process is warranted for the review of the Application.
